TAX PENALTY & INSTALLMENT PAYMENT BYLAW

BYLAW 2019-004

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CAROLINE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES AND INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, the Council may pass bylaws regarding penalty for non-payment of taxes;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Caroline, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. A penalty of ten percent (10%) shall be applied to all current taxes owing at the close of business on July 31 of each year. Should July 31 not be a business day, the penalty shall not be applied until the close of business on the following business day.
2. A penalty of fourteen percent (14%) shall be applied to all arrears owing at the close of business on December 31 of each year. Should December 31 not be a business day, the penalty shall not be applied until the close of business on the following business day.

AND FURTHER THAT Bylaw 2015-005 is hereby rescinded and all other previous related bylaws.

AND FURTHER THAT this by-law shall come into effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a first time this 14 day of May, 2019

READ a second time this 14 day of May, 2019.

Given **UNANIMOUS** consent to go to third reading on this 14 day of May, 2019

READ a third and final time this 14 day of May, 2019.
